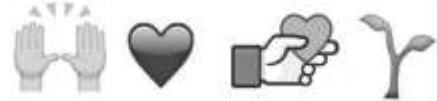

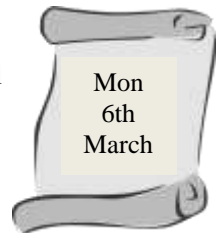

#### \* REVISION OF THE ELECTORAL ROLL \*

As the APCM is at the end of March, it will soon be time for another revision of the church's Electoral Roll. The Electoral Roll is the list of those qualified to attend and vote at the Annual Parochial Church Meeting where the elections take place for the PCC and the parish's representatives on the Deanery Synod.



Anyone entitled to attend the APCM may raise any question of parish or general church interest. This year we only need to have a revision of the Electoral Roll. Notices about the revision period will be displayed at all three churches – it begins on Sunday 12 February and the closing date is Monday 6 March.

Please let me know about anyone who should be removed from the Electoral Roll or whose address or contact details have changed.

If you are not on the Electoral Roll yet, but would like to be added because you consider yourself a member of one of the churches in our parish, please fill in an application form (available in all our churches), sign it and pass it to one of the churchwardens or directly to me. You need to be baptised and aged 16 or over and either resident in the parish or, if not resident, you need to have attended public worship regularly at one of our churches in the last six months. I look forward to receiving some new forms before the closing date on 6th March!

**RACHEL'S RAMBLINGS**

*Birthday presents, Valentine's Day gifts, 'Get Well Soon' cards - why do we give them? Why not just use words to say how much we love and appreciate our friends and families? We could come up with all sorts of reasons to ditch our gift and card giving habits but I think they tap into our desire to express ourselves through our actions as well as our words. 'I love you' feels more complete when accompanied by a kiss and a bunch of roses (or a tub of their namesakes!).*
