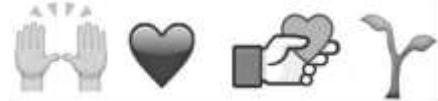

You need to be baptised and aged 16 or over and either resident in the parish or, if not resident, you need to have attended public worship regularly at one of our churches in the last six months.
