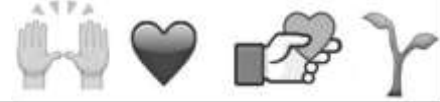

A reminder that both the £5 note and £1 coin are changing this year. The new "plastic" £5 note is already in circulation. You will not be able to use the previous version after 5 May 2017. The new 12 sided £1 coin comes in next month. The current round coin will cease

being accepted on 15 October 2017.

**The Rev'd Beverley Hunt**

**Our new Associate Minister, Beverley Hunt, will be licensed at a Parish United Service at St Peter's next Sunday 5 March at 10.00am.**

Below is a short biography which she wrote. Please pray for her.



Prior to training for ordained ministry, Beverley worked mainly in public sector organisations, e.g. the NHS (Nursing Sister) and Higher Education (Lecturer and Head of Department). She held the dual role at the King's Fund, London as: *Fellow in Leadership Development* and *Senior Adviser on Race and Diversity*. Her work was focused on enabling individuals to develop their leadership capacity, creativity and growth. She has facilitated personal and organisational development and change; and is passionate about work that seeks to transform people's lives.

These are the kind of values and skills that Beverley has brought to ministry. She feels that God equips us for the work he has called us to do; something that is evident in her life. Having served her curacy in East Molesey, she held another dual role as the *Diocesan End-of-Curacy Assessor* and the *Team Vicar in the Parish of Godalming*, as well as being a School Governor there. She was recently back as interim priest at St Paul's, East Molesey, supporting the church and community as they prepared to move on to the next stage in their missional journey to increase and nurture new believers in their faith.

Working with the Barbados High Commission, Beverley has valued the opportunity to work with Barbadian diaspora in the UK, officiating at services, preaching at UK-wide services, and generally supporting organisations and their leaders as appropriate. She is the *Diocesan Representative for national Committee of Minority Ethnic Anglican Concerns*, and is leading on the vocational aspects of these concerns for the diocese.

Among other qualifications, Beverley has a DipHE in Ministry Studies, MA Medical Law and Ethics and BEd (Hons) Nursing Education. She feels that her love for

God and people, together with resilience, commitment and a passion for whatever she is doing has helped her enormously. She lives in Woking with her husband, Geoff, a professor in Philosophy. Their three children have 'flown the nest' - but there are seven lovely grandchildren.
