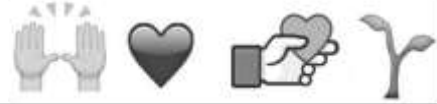

*** HAVE YOU SEEN A NEW POUND COIN YET? ***



A reminder that both the £5 note and £1 coin are changing this year.

The new "plastic" £5 note is already in circulation. You will not be able to use the previous version after 5 May 2017. The new 12 sided £1 coin is now in circulation.

The current round coin will cease being accepted on 15 October 2017.

This may seem a long way off but best to check now if you have any old notes or coins in savings jars, group petty cash boxes, subscription tins, mission partner collection pots etc etc. Church savings are not exempt!



REV BEV'S REFLECTION

Recently I was reading Jesus' Great Commission (Matthew 28.16-20) and was struck afresh by the task before us to 'make disciples'. I think that it is often easier for us to go and "baptise them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teach them to obey everything I [Jesus] have commanded you," than to make disciples of them. I have been reflecting on this as it raised a number of questions for me. It also spoke to me about obedience and transformation through the acceptance and love of Jesus who will not forsake us but is with us always, even to the end of time.
